


## INTERNATIONAL SUMMER PROGRAM

The Albert Summer School is organized into theoretical and practical courses arranged in **four distinct pillars** that allow students to master both aspects of the program: data and business. The program is also punctuated by one **entrepreneurial project** lasting 2 weeks, enabling students to apply their knowledge and skills in real-world conditions. We believe that an excellent education isn't necessarily composed solely of theory but should also incorporate practical experience.



The group entrepreneurial project will culminate in a corporate pitch at **Station F**, the world's largest startup campus.



#### **◆ COST OF THE PROGRAM**

Tuition fees: €2,200 for two weeks.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### What if I am under 18 and I want to go out?

For older teens to be allowed to go out on their own, explicit written consent from the parents or legal guardians is required.

#### Parents should specify:

Whether their child is allowed to leave the premises without supervision. Any limitations on the duration, time, or type of outings (e.g., only during daylight hours, specific areas).

#### Do I need a visa to attend the program?

Depending on your nationality, you may need a visa to study in France. We recommend checking with the French embassy or consulate in your country. Upon admission, we can provide an official acceptance letter to support your visa application.

#### What language is the program taught in?

The Summer School is taught entirely in English. Proficiency in English is essential to fully benefit from the program.
